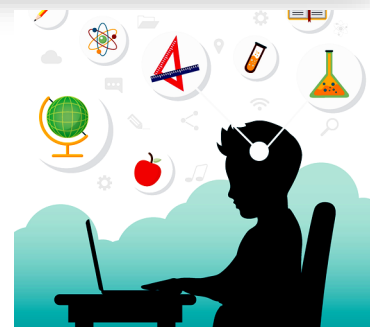




Interactive Learning Resources
